DROP BOX TERMS & CONDITIONS

Dear Valued Customer,

This handout contains **5** important items of information and **your signature at the bottom is required.** Please fax this signed form, to our office, acknowledging the conditions & use of this box, prior to box delivery. Fax#: 541-826-5361

#1:All temporary boxes are payable in advance, before delivery. We accept Visa & Mastercard over the phone or payments can be made at our office located at 8001 Table Rock Rd., White City, OR 97503.

#2:No hazardous waste or asbestos of any kind or any amount is allowed. **All construction demolition boxes MUST have asbestos abatement certification on file in our office, PRIOR to box delivery.**

#3:The following conditions must be met before we can empty/remove a rented drop box:

- **** VERY IMPORTANT **** Dirt, rock, concrete, brick, glass, pumice block and composition 3-tab roofing, as well as other various construction debris, are considered compact waste. Special rates, box sizes and load levels apply and are determined by the type and weight of material.

For Example: 10 yd compact boxes can be filled with most compact debris but not all. A few exceptions are: dirt, rock, brick, gravel, sand can **ONLY** be filled up to 7 yds in a 10yd box. Additionally, due to weight restrictions, these heavy materials are not accepted at all in a 20yd box.

- No liquids, no paints.
- No tanks, barrels or 55-gallon drums that have not been properly prepared for disposal.
- No tires, air conditioners, large appliances, water heaters
- No electronic waste: computer monitors, TV's, microwaves, etc.
- No fluorescent tubes or ballasts.
- No automobile/motorcycle parts.

#4:An additional "trip charge" may apply when scheduled box hauls or deliveries are not cancelled in advance by calling our office at (541) 779-4161. This call must be made **BEFORE** the driver is scheduled to arrive.

#5:Because we did not decide the location of the drop box on your property we cannot be responsible for any accident or damages that may occur after the drop box is placed.

DROP BOX TERMS & CONDITIONS (cont.)

If any unacceptable items are found, the customer is responsible for all costs and fines for proper disposal.

- The load is to be level at the top of the box or specified “fill mark”, not the cross bar above gates.
- The customer is responsible for overload citations
